When he got married he not only invited me to his wedding in Vienna Austria he also paid for the entire trip. Round trip airfare, hotel for 2 weeks, and \$1,500 in spending money. When I needed a break from life during a difficult time while I was getting divorced he put me up in San Mateo at one of his partners condos, lent me a Mercedes and put me to work for four entire months. His partner was deliquet ont in paying taxes and ended up crashing their business. Adam could not control his partner. The last time I saw him happy was around 2014 when he met the love of his life Tiffany Gillette. I had visited them both in November and then tragedy struck and Tiffany was killed in a car crash along with her step father. It was then that Adam took a turn for the worst. After losing the business and then Tiffany he slipped. And prior to his death he was trying so hard to bring himself back from the abyss. He tried very hard and was able to secure a very lucrative job in Austin with the dept of water and power. Unfortunately, he wasn't able to kick the habit and no one was there to revive him.
