Carol Nayfach Kaufmann, 81, passed away on April 4, 2023. 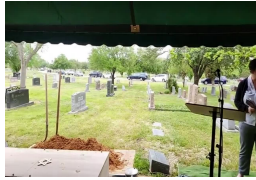
