Howard Marshall Levett was born November 6, 1949, in Dallas, Texas, and died suddenly December 21, 2023. He received his B.A. from the University of Texas at El Paso and his M.A. from the University of Texas at Austin.

Marshall set up the first independent living center in El Paso before moving to Austin where he was a counselor for Austin Community College for 34 years. He thoroughly enjoyed his contact with hundreds of students and then children of former students.

Marshall was heavily involved in disability rights activism on the local and state levels. He was a proud Democrat and loyal long-suffering fan of the Dallas Cowboys. He was a member of Congregation Beth Shalom.

He leaves behind his wife Susan, sons Carlos, Alan and Paul and their families.
