



## Ira Sydney Goodman

May 14, 1934 - September 17, 2024

Ira Goodman of Austin, Texas, passed away on September 17th, 2024, at the age of 90. He was born on May 14th, 1934, to Morris and Diana (Nurenberg) Goodman in New York City. He graduated from DeWitt Clinton High School, received a bachelor's degree from City College of New York and a master's degree in accounting from NYU. Ira went on to have a very successful 38 year career at IBM as a Programming Manager.

He met his wife of 67 years, Lois, at a pool club in the Bronx in 1956 and they married in 1957. Ira and Lois raised their two boys (David and Gary) in Poughkeepsie, New York.

Lois and Ira moved to Austin, Texas, in 1994 and he retired in 2000 after leading his IBM programming group through Y2K. In retirement Ira and Lois

took many Adult Ed classes at UT and officiated junior tennis tournaments. He adored his grandchildren (Aaron, Casey, Kirby and Brett) traveling with them to Costa Rica, Mexico, Iceland and various U.S. locations. He especially loved to attend their various sporting activities.

Ira was an avid newshound throughout his lifetime always keeping up to date and discussing world events with family and friends especially anything related to Israel.

Ira was preceded in death by his parents Morris and Diana (Nurenberg) Goodman and sister Elaine (Goodman) Kallman. He's survived by wife Lois, sons, David (Rita) and Gary (Lisa) Goodman; and his grandchildren, Aaron, Casey, Kirby and Brett Goodman.
