Jay Mark Hoffman was born on May 24, 1963 in Fort Worth, Texas to Sandra a"l and Alexander z"l Hoffman.

He graduated from Trinity Valley School in the Class of 1981. Jay worked at Tandy Radio Shack for 17+ years rising to the level of Senior Store Manager. In 1996 he started a business called Republic of Texas Provision Company. After working in retail sales and as a tech support consultant, 10 years ago he started and ran a printing business which was his baby, Eagle Office Products.

Jay was quite involved in his community civics, volunteering for TEXSAR, Austin Amateur Radio Club, Travis County ARES, Children's Miracle Network, Woody Pet Therapy and Austin Aqua Festival. He was a board member at Hired Texas, Austin Independent Business Alliance, Choose Austin First, Austin/Travis County CERT and AJS. 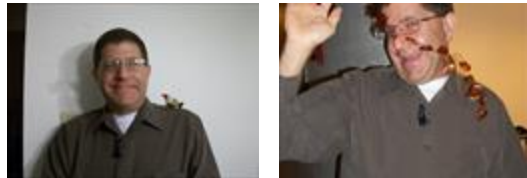
