January 30, 1940 - February 7, 2026

Joseph John Foli, a devoted educator, faithful member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and cherished husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, passed away peacefully on February 6, 2026, at the age of 86.

Born on January 30, 1940, in Spring Valley, Illinois. Joseph (known to many as Joe or Mr. Foli) earned a Masters degree in Education and dedicated much of his professional life to teaching, primarily sixth grade students in the Chillicothe, Missouri, school district. His commitment to nurturing young minds left a lasting impact on generations of students in the community.

In his twenties, Joseph converted to The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (the Mormon faith) and remained an active and devoted member throughout his life, placing his faith in God and his loyalty to Jesus Christ at the forefront of his priorities.
