



Peter Anastasios Mountzouris

March 9, 1942 - October 20, 2025

Peter Anastasios Mountzouris, known as Petros to family, died October 20, 2025, in Austin, Texas. He was born in 1941 in Homatero, a village in the Peloponnese Peninsula of Greece. His early years coincided with the German occupation of the country in World War II which cast a shadow over his childhood. However, his parents never let him lose sight of the importance of education. The youngest of five children, Peter was the first to graduate from high school. Opportunities were limited in Greece as civil war followed the German occupation. With his parents' blessing and \$50 in his pocket, Peter left his country in 1961 for the United States. He attended the University of Houston while working in various restaurants. In 1963 he married Jannette Peebles whom he met at the university. She survives him. He became a naturalized citizen of the United States in 1967 prior to beginning his thirty-one year career with IBM. Peter was of the Greek Orthodox faith.

Peter is survived by two children, a daughter-in-law, and two grandchildren. Several cousins, nieces, and nephews also survive him. His parents, sister, and three brothers predeceased him.
