Robert William Nicholson, 83, passed away on Saturday February 8, 2025 at Saint David's Hospital in Austin, Texas. Robert was born Sunday, June 1, 1941 to Paul Joseph and Dorothy Nicholson in Corpus Christi, Texas. The family settled in Midland Texas, where Robert graduated from Midland High School in 1959.

After high school, Robert attended the University of Texas where he earned his Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology and Economics. During this time, Robert also worked at Austin State Hospital, where he would later dedicate the majority of his career.

After college, Robert joined the American Red Cross working both in the U.S. and overseas during the Vietnam War from 1961 to 1965. When he came back home, he returned to Austin State Hospital as a caseworker.

On December 19, 1970, Robert married Margaret Jane Lewis and had three children together. When his youngest was a baby, he returned to school to earn his Master of Science degree in Health Professions from Southwest Texas State University. Robert continued working at Austin State Hospital as a social worker and case manager providing and overseeing social services, therapy, and integration of patients back into society until his retirement in 2006.

Robert spent a few of his retired years living in Honolulu, Hawaii, ultimately returning to Austin to enjoy the company of his children and grandchildren. He embraced nature with his walks around the lake, as well as various other hobbies.

He will be dearly missed and a place will remain set for him at the game table among his beloved children.

Robert is preceded in death by his parents, Dorothy and Paul Nicholson, brother Joe Nicholson, and many beloved cousins, aunts, and uncles. He is survived by his sons Nathan (Yi) and Willie (Irma) and daughter Carrie (Mike) Aaron and three grandchildren,

Aaron, Nicole and Kayla; niece Kelleigh (Cory) Satterfield, and great nieces Ava and Zoe, as well as numerous cousins and relatives.
