On Wednesday, November 30, 2022, Robert Allen Robinson, "Bob", loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, passed away at the age of 83.

Bob was born on August 11, 1939 in Hollywood, California. He graduated from Cal High, Whittier in 1957. He was attending Cal State University before enlisting in the US Air Force in 1960 and was stationed in France. After returning from duty in 1964, he met Brenda Hinson and they were married in November. He went on to earn a BA in Business Administration from CSU in 1968 and then his BS in Environmental Engineering in 1973 from Cal Poly SLO, while becoming a Journeyman and working as a refrigeration pipefitter and welder. In 1978 he started with Brown and Root and for over 35 years and was stationed all over the world including; Venezuela, Alaska, France, England, Chad Africa, Iraq, Germany, Singapore, Afghanistan and Saudi Arabia. In August of 2000, he and four other engineers were granted a patent for their invention AQUAFORM™, a Rotary Head Design for Petroleum Resid Pelletization. He was a Master Mason of 55 years and a member of the Sugar Land Masonic Lodge #1411 for 40 years.

Bob was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Brenda, and his son Scott. He is survived by his daughter, Dawn Forman, his identical twin brother, Ronald Robinson, his wife Brunhilda, as well as his grandchildren Bair, Baxter,

Bailey and Blaze (Dawn's children) and J.Robert, Scottie, Tanner and Dorie (Scott's children) and great grandsons, Aidan and Tristen, as well as nieces and nephews.
