



## Dr. Saul Benjamin Wilen

August 1, 1945 - October 13, 2019

Saul Benjamin Wilen, MD was born on August 1, 1945 in Brooklyn NY and passed away on October 13, 2019 in Austin, TX. He grew up in Queens, NY, was an Eagle Scout, and a NY State Regent Scholar. Saul attended Northwestern University in Evanston, Ill and State University of New York Downstate Medical Center (SUNY), completing a residency in Internal Medicine with a subspecialty in Pulmonary Medicine. Saul served in the US military as a physician at the School of Aerospace Medicine at Brooks Air Force Base, San Antonio, TX from 1974 -1976, and practiced pulmonary/critical care medicine in private practice in San Antonio for 25 years. He then became CEO of International Horizons, Unlimited, an educational consulting company based in San Antonio, retiring in 2006.

Saul was preceded in death by his parents, Harry and Ida Wilen. He is survived by his wife Ruth Fagan-Wilen; three children, Howard (and Emily) Wilen; Hana (and Aviad) Shany, and Joshua Wilen; stepdaughter Rachel Fagan (and Rob Rosenblatt), and stepson David Fagan (and Marnie Fagan); and 6 adored grandchildren: Chloe and Ian Fagan; Ella and Lexi Rosenblatt, and Yarden & Erez Shany. Saul is also survived by his brother Ron (and Robin) Wilen and numerous nieces and nephews.

Saul served on many San Antonio community boards: The Carver Cultural Center as President of the Board; Meal on Wheels of San Antonio; and the

Jewish Community Center of San Antonio. He was honored by these organizations for the many fund-raisers he headed, leading to the organizations' stability and longevity. Saul was also a gourmet cook, gardener, and especially loved being with his beloved children and grandchildren.
