Shawn Allen Bucklin, 51, of Kingsland, Texas passed away on Thursday, October 5, 2023. He was born on October 21, 1972 to Dawn and Duane Bucklin. He attended Forest Hills Central High School in Grand Rapids, Michigan and Northern Michigan University in Marquette, Michigan where he met the love of his life, Sandra Lynn Bucklin, and were married on May 8, 2003. They were a part of each other's lives for 30-years.

Shawn will be remembered for his superior athletic ability, competitive spirit, and unique talent of being the best at anything he put his mind to. He held the record for most interceptions by a defensive back during his high school football career. He was a self-taught musician, with a passion for playing guitar and jazz music, which culminated into being a part of a great band and producing an album. His greatest pride was honing the skills and developments of each player, rather than winning the game. He stressed above all the importance of hard work and perseverance.

Shawn was a stellar movie picker, life of the party, and had the funniest dance moves. His children, Cara and Cash, say that the number one word to describe their father is "goofy".

His love for negotiating and servitude lofted him into real estate, where he was a partner at Austin Home and Loan for 19-years. He spent many years of his career managing highly complex logistics projects for some of the largest multi-national corporations. In all of his professional endeavors, he possessed a true passion for his clients and provided them with the highest level of customer service. He always went above and beyond.

Inspired by the passing of his brother, Brock, Shawn was a founding and active board member of the Folds of Honor of Central Texas. He was dedicated to their mission of raising significant funds for scholarship programs for the children of fallen soldiers.

Shawn's greatest accomplishment in life was bringing his two children into this world. 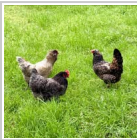
