Stanley (z"l) was born in Shreveport, Louisiana and attended high school in Artesia, New Mexico before making his way to Austin to attend the University of Texas where he studied business. He was an athlete throughout his childhood, particularly loving basketball and golf, and running in multiple marathons even as an adult.

He started work in the family business of Hobbs Pipe and Supply before moving to Midland, Texas to open his own business with his brother-in-law. Eventually, the pull of family brought him and Mary Jane back to Austin, though he maintained relationships with customers throughout Texas long after he moved, living his values of helping people and cultivating friendships

throughout his life. He was a passionate and devoted volunteer in many organizations. Judaism was always a core component of his home, and he loved combining his passions of Judaism and cooking. CAA was his spiritual home and a place of comfort and community. He treasured his family above all else. He will be deeply missed. He was 92.
